Directions for Submitting Art Entries

Artwork can only be dropped off between **April 6** and **April 15**.

The Artwork Entry Label must be attached to the artwork.

Artwork must be delivered unframed and **ready to hang**. This means that a hook or wire must be affixed to the back of the mat. **Please note that adhesive hooks are no longer accepted**. Please ensure hanging material is sturdy enough for heavier pieces. Artwork that is not completely dry when delivered or in a condition other than ready to hang may or may not be displayed depending upon available space. Artwork must arrive in a portfolio or other packaging **EVEN IF** you are delivering in person.

Artwork can be delivered in person or by mail to Congressman Welch's Burlington office. Office hours are 9 am to 5pm Monday through Friday.
